(TOO MANY) GOALS

Our worthy Newsletter Editor's love of statistics has meant that many times during the past season attention has been drawn to the number of goals scored on a specific day in the Sydenhams League and rightly so. Goals are what football is about – though a large number of Premiership Clubs do not seemingly subscribe to that opinion – but, and this question has been asked before, can too many goals be a bad thing.

The North Devon League boasts four Divisions – Premier, Senior, Intermediate One and Two – and feeds in to the South West Peninsula League so one imagines is possibly Steps Eight and Nine though matters below Step Seven are difficult to clarify.

No doubt due to the weather and lack of facilities for midweek games, their season did not finish until May 26th when there were eighteen games spread across the four divisions – and those 18 games produced a grand total of 164 goals which constitutes an average of nine goals a game.

Over half of these came in the Premier Division where League Champions Park United defeated bottom Club Barnstaple 20-0 and third place Boca Seniors – what a superb name – scored 23 without reply against sixth place Fremington. North Molton Sports Club weighed in with ten at Shebbear United and every game in the Division on the day had at least five goals. Individual results and scorers for the season are not readily available but Park United finished with a goal difference of plus 134 whilst Barnstaple's was minus 277 which means they were ten goals adrift in nearly every game.

The Senior Division was a little more "civilised" – one game finished 0-1 – but Fremington Reserves made up slightly for their first team by scoring eleven without reply against Georgeham and Croyde.

There were only three matches in the Intermediate One Division but with Hartland Clovelly Reserves and Torrington Reserves both scoring nine against Appledore Lions and Bideford Community AFC Reserves respectively, the Division contributed fully to the days total.

Five games in Intermediate Two with four worthy of mention. Bideford Community AFC 3rds, who won the League comfortably, defeated fifth place Woolacombe eight seven – far from the most common of scorelines – whilst Woolserly won six three at Eastside. This is not particularly unusual but Woolserly is actually Woolfardisworthy near Bideford with the Village and Club apparently and preferably better known as Woolserly.

Finally in this Division Appledore Thirds and Combe Martin Reserves "appear" to have played each other twice on the same day. "Appear" because of the co-incidence in the scoreline with Appledore winning both games by six goals to nil. It is suggested that both games were of an hours duration but where they were played is not obvious. The two Clubs are some twenty miles apart and it surely suggests that both games were played at one venue. If that were the case then both Clubs are to be commended for getting the games

played. [Different scorers and match referees suggests these were two separate games, reinforced by the fact that Appledore kicked off their "home" game at 16:30, the "away" game at the standard 15:00 time- Ed]

So, a goal strewn day in North Devon and it is stressed that the purpose of this is not to belittle any Club or anybody – those who were heavily defeated on the day, and in a couple of cases, throughout the season deserve credit for keeping going but results such as 23-0 are surely no fun for anybody. I have never seen anybody score more than fourteen and on the two occasions that happened the final whistle could not come soon enough. But you pay your money and take your choice.
